COOKIE POLICY

I. GENERAL INFORMATION.

1. The Operator of the performancelabs.pl website is Performance Labs Sp. z o.o. with its registered seat in Warsaw at St. Ks. J. Poniatowskiego 1, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs National Court Register by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw, XII Economic Division of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000593459, with NIP number: 701-05-32-297

2. The Service performs functions to obtain information about users and their behaviour in the following ways:

- 1. Through information voluntarily entered on the forms.
- 2. By storing cookies ("cookies") on your end devices.
- 3. By collecting web server logs by the hosting operator Hostovita.pl

II. INFORMATION ABOUT COOKIES.

- 1. This website uses cookies.
- Cookies (so-called "cookies") are computer data, in particular text files, which are stored in the Service User's terminal equipment and are intended for use on the Website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they come, the time of storing them on the terminal equipment and a unique number.
- 3. The entity placing cookies on the Website User's terminal equipment and accessing them is the Website operator.
- 4. Cookies are used for the following purposes:
 - a) creating statistics that help to understand how users of the Service use websites, which enables improving their structure and content;
 - b) maintaining a session of the Service User (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter login and password on each subpage of the Service;
 - c) profiling you in order to show you tailored content on advertising networks, in particular the Google network.
- 5. There are two main types of cookies used within the Service: "session" (session cookies) and "permanent" (persistent cookies). Session" cookies are temporary files that are stored in the final device of the User until logging out, leaving the website or switching off software (web browser). "Permanent" cookies are stored in the final device of the User for the time specified in the parameters of cookies or until they are deleted by the User.

- 6. Web browsing software (internet browser) usually allows by default to store cookies on User's end device. Users of the Website can change their settings in this regard. Internet browser allows to delete cookies. It is also possible to block cookies automatically. Detailed information on this subject can be found in help or documentation of a web browser.
- 7. Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionality available on the Website.
- 8. Cookies placed in Service User's end device and used can also be by advertisers and partners cooperating with Service Operator.

- 10. Cookies may be used by advertising networks, in particular the Google network, to display advertisements tailored to the way the user uses the Website. For this purpose, they may store information about the user's navigation path or the time spent on a particular page.
