

# PRIVACY POLICY

## I. GENERAL INFORMATION.

1. The Operator of the performancelabs.pl website is Performance Labs Sp. z o.o. with its registered seat in Warsaw at St. Ks. J. Poniatowskiego 1, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs National Court Register by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw, XII Economic Division of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000593459, with NIP number: 701-05-32-297

2. The Service performs functions to obtain information about users and their behaviour in the following ways:

1. Through information voluntarily entered on the forms.
2. By storing cookies ("cookies") on your end devices.
3. By collecting web server logs by the hosting operator Hostovita.pl

## II. INFORMATION IN THE FORMS.

1. The Service collects information voluntarily provided by the user.
2. The service may also store information about the connection parameters (time stamp, IP address)
3. The data in the form are not made available to third parties other than with your consent.
4. Data provided in the form may constitute a set of potential clients, registered by the Operator of the Service in the register kept by the General Inspector for Personal Data Protection.
5. The data provided in the form is processed for the purpose resulting from the function of a particular form, e.g. for the service request process or business contact.
6. Data provided in the forms may be forwarded to entities technically performing certain services - in particular, it concerns forwarding information about the holder of the registered domain to entities being domain operators the Internet (especially the Research and Academic Computer Network - NASK), payment services or other entities with which the Operator of the Website cooperates in this area.
7. By filling out the contact form, the user agrees to processing of his/her personal data by Performance Labs Sp. z o.o. based in Warsaw, st. Aleja Księcia Józefa Poniatowskiego 1, for marketing and advertising purposes in accordance with the Act of 29 August 1997 on the Protection of Personal Data (Journal of Laws of 2014, item 1182, as amended). The data is provided voluntarily. The user has the right to inspect their data and correct them.

### **III. SERVER LOGS.**

1. Information certain user behaviour is subject to logging in the server layer. These data is used solely for the purpose of administration of the service and to ensure the most efficient operation of the provided hosting services.
2. The viewed resources are identified by URLs. In addition, the record may be subject to:
  1. the time of arrival of the query,
  2. response posting time,
  3. the name of the client station - identification carried out by the HTTP protocol,
  4. Information about errors that occurred during the HTTP transaction,
  5. the URL of the page previously visited by the user (referrer link) – if you have accessed the Website via a link,
  6. information about your browser,
  7. IP Address Information.
3. The above data is not associated with specific visitors.
4. The above data is used only for server administration purposes.

### **IV. DATA SHARING.**

1. Data shall only be made available to external parties within the limits of the law.
2. Personally identifiable information is shared only with the consent of the individual.
3. The Operator may be required to provide information collected by the Service to authorized authorities based on lawful requests to the extent of the request.
